



2010 INDIVIDUAL BREED RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1) **The Absolute Deadline for all cattle entries is December 1, 2009!**
- 2) **The \$150 entry fee must be paid before an entry will be accepted!**
 - Entries mailed with no entry fee will NOT be cataloged!
- 3) **Entries will be accepted online at our website: www.necattlemen.com**
 - Read the Online Instructions carefully before beginning the online entry process.
 - Read each online entry page carefully! It will tell you exactly what to do!
 - If there are any questions about the online entry process, please contact the Classic Office at 308.627.6385!
- 4) **After entry is done online, you must send in your signed consignor consent form, along with copies of registration papers, entry fees, and pictures to the Classic Office. (PO Box 607, Kearney, NE 68848)**

 - Pictures are highly recommended for HELPING YOU sell YOUR ANIMAL!
 - The best way to submit your picture is by e-mail.
 - Make sure you send your picture as a FILE ATTACHMENT to rkbush@frontiernet.net

- Entries must be a Horned Hereford according to the American Hereford Association.
- Entries shall be subject to approval by a selection committee appointed by the NHA board.
- All eligible female entries must include a check for \$50 made payable to the NHA for the Junior Futurity.
- The Nebraska Hereford Association charges an additional 1% sales commission.

POLLED HEREFORDS

OPEN SALE - Bulls and Females - The 2010 Polled Hereford Show will be a fit show.

- Consignors must be members of the Nebraska Hereford Association.
- Entries must be a Polled Hereford according to the American Hereford Association.
- Entries shall be subject to approval by a selection committee appointed by the NHA board.
- All eligible female entries must include a check for \$50 made payable to the NHA for the Junior Futurity.
- The Nebraska Hereford Association charges an additional 1% sales commission.

RED ANGUS

OPEN SALE - Bulls and Females - The 2010 Red Angus Show will be a no fit show.

- Consignors must be a member of the Nebraska Red Angus Association.
- Entries must be registered as a 1A or 1B Red Angus with the Red Angus Association.
- Heifer calves (born after January 1, 2009 and before August 31, 2009) must be entered in the NRAA Futurity to be paid out at the Junior Beef Expo and the Nebraska State Fair. All heifer calf entries must include a \$50 payable to the NRA.

ANGUS

CLOSED SALE - Bulls and Females - The 2010 Angus Show will be a fit show.

- Consignors are limited to current members of the NE Angus Association, operating legitimately within the state of Nebraska.
- A NAA member must appear as the first owner on the registration papers to show at the Classic.
- Entries are limited to 70-75 head, consisting of approximately 50 bulls and 25 heifers. Each consignor will be allowed to sell at least one bull and/or heifer. If the desired head count is not met, additional entries will be taken based on tenure.
- Entries shall be subject to approval by NAA Screening Committee. The Committee reserves the right to reject any animal not meeting NAA qualifications of eligibility, conformation and structure.
- Entries will be weighed to provide supplemental information at the sale.
- Entries will not be accepted unless memberships to the NAA have been paid.

SIMMENTAL

OPEN SALE - Bulls and Females - The 2010 Simmental Show will be a fit show.

- Consignors must be members of the Nebraska Simmental Association.
- Entries must be registered with the American Simmental Association. (Non-Simmental Sired entries ARE allowed)
- Bulls must be born prior to March 31, 2009 and must pass a semen test prior to the Classic.
- Entries registered as a 1/2 blood Simmental or higher are allowed. (Non-Simmental Sired entries ARE allowed)
- An EPD, weight, and scrotal measurement data sheet will be made. The sheet will be given to the judge to use.
- The NSA charges an additional 1% sales commission.

CHAROLAIS

- BAAROE (Braunvieh Association of America Ring of Excellence) rules apply.
- BAAROE points will be awarded based on class placing.

LIMOUSIN

OPEN SALE - Bulls and Females - The 2010 Limousin Show will be a no fit show.

- Consignors must be a member of the Nebraska Limousin Association.
- Entries must be registered with North American Limousin Foundation.
- Entries must be registered as LimFlex (50% or greater).
- Entries not registered as a LimFlex or purebred, must be a registered as 3/4 blood or higher.
- Entries will be ultrasounded at the Classic to provide a supplement sheet to buyers.
- Yearling bulls will have a minimum adjusted scrotal of 31 cm. Entries will be weighed and measured at the show.
- Bulls born after January 1, 2009 has to have a 2.6 WPD of age.
- Heifers born January 1, 2008 to August 1, 2008 must be bred.
- The Nebraska Limousin Association will receive 1% commission of sales.

GELBVIEH/BALANCER

OPEN SALE - Bulls and Females - The 2010 Gelbvieh/Balancer Show will be a no fit show and both will show together.

- Consignors must be members of both the Nebraska and American Gelbvieh Associations for 2009 Out of state consignors may buy a membership for \$50.
- Entries must be registered as Purebred Gelbvieh or as Balancers with the American Gelbvieh Association.
- Heifers born prior to June 1, 2008 must be safe in calf or have a calf at side.
- Entries will be weighed and scrotal measured at check-in. This information will be in the show programs.

SHORTHORN

OPEN SALE - (The 2010 Show will be open to all states.) - Bulls and Females - The 2010 Shorthorn Show will be a fit show.

- Consignors must be members of the Nebraska Shorthorn Association.
- Entries must be registered as a Purebred with the American Shorthorn Association.
- If consignors bring more than 2 bulls they must bring 1 heifer.
- No bulls will be accepted with a birth weight over 99 pounds.
- Bulls must be born prior to April 30th, 2009.
- Heifer calf entries must include a check for \$50 made payable to NSA for the Junior Futurity. All heifers are eligible for the Nebraska Club Calf Spectacular Show Back.
- Entries must be TH tested unless the parents are verified TH Free. Results must be provided with entry.

MAINE ANJOU AND MAINETAINER

OPEN SALE - Bulls and Females - The 2010 Maine Anjou and Maintainer Show will be a fit show.

- Consignors must be members of the Nebraska Maine Association.
- Previous consignors have priority with entries.
- Entries must carry Maine Anjou or MaineTainer papers.
- Bulls must test negative for TH and PHA in order to be sold at the Nebraska Cattlemen's Classic.
- Bulls will be ultrasounded.
- Bulls are required to have a minimum scrotal measurement of 30 cm adjusted to 1 year of age.
- Heifers can have an optional ultrasound.
- Heifers must be TH and PHA tested. Results must be provided with the entry.
- Bred heifers must be bred to a bull that is TH and PHA Free.

CHIMAINÉ

OPEN SALE - Bulls and Females - The 2010 Chimaine Show will be a fit show.

- Entries must be registered as a Chimaine in the American Chianina Association.
- Bulls have a minimum scrotal measurement is 28 cm unless the bull has satisfactory semen tests.
- Bulls over one year must have satisfactory semen test.
- Bulls under the age of 18 months will have a mandatory ultrasound. (This is optional for bulls over 18 months.)
- Bulls must test negative for TH and PHA in order to be sold at the Nebraska Cattlemen's Classic.**
- Heifers must be TH and PHA tested. Results must be provided with entry.**
- Heifers can also have an optional ultrasound.
- Heifer calves born prior to August 31, 2009 will be accepted.
- Entries will sell under terms and conditions of the ACA.
- Entries must be sent with registration papers.

CHIANGUS

OPEN SALE - Bulls and Females - The 2010 Chiangus Show will be a fit show.

- Entries must be registered as a Chiangus or Chianina in the American Chianina Association and they must be black.
- Bulls have a minimum scrotal measurement is 28 cm unless the bull has satisfactory semen tests.
- Bulls under the age of 18 months will have a mandatory ultrasound. (This is optional for bulls over 18 months.)
- Heifers can also have an optional ultrasound.
- Bulls must test negative for TH and PHA in order to be sold at the Nebraska Cattlemen's Classic.**
- Heifers must be TH and PHA tested. Results must be provided with entry.**
- Heifer calves born prior to August 31, 2009 will be accepted.
- Entries will sell under terms and conditions of the ACA.
- Entries must be sent with registration papers.
- Entries must be AM tested. Results must be provided with entry.**
