1. THE ENTRY DEADLINE IS NOVEMBER 25, 2016. LATE ENTRIES SUBJECT TO A \$50 LATE FEE.

2. The \$150 entry fee must be paid before an entry will be accepted.

• Entries mailed with no entry fee will NOT be cataloged!

• Read the Online Instructions carefully before beginning the online entry process. If you have entered on line before, make sure you use your user name and password to obtain your file already in the computer. JUST HIT SEND ME MY LOGIN!

4. After entry is done online, you must send in your signed consignor consent form, along with copies of registration papers, entry fees, and pictures to the Classic Office (PO Box 607, Kearney, NE 68848).

5. Please contact Ronette on the correct way to submit a picture at 308.627.6385. ALL PICTURES ARE FREE! Classic Management reserves the right to determine the usage of the picture. Pictures for print must be submitted with entries. On-line pictures can be added at anytime. Pictures are highly recommended for HELPING YOU sell YOUR ANIMAL!

6. All Individual Breed Rules are set in cooperation with the respective Breed Association. All entries are subject to a screening committee approval.

• All entries are eligible to compete in the Nebraska Cattlemen's Classic Supreme Row if selected as the Breed Champion.

7. All animals, unless screened, must sell. The sale commission is 13.25% on the sale price. A minimum of 50% of an animal must sell.

The Nebraska Cattlemen's Classic reserves to management the final and absolute right to interpret this rules and regulations and to arbitrarily settle or determine all matters, questions or differences in regard to the show and sale.

(Non-Simmental Sired entries ARE allowed) • Bulls must be born prior to March 31, 2016 and must pass a semen test prior to the Classic. • Entries registered as a 1/2 blood Simmental or higher are allowed. (Non-Simmental Sired entries ARE allowed) • There will be a "Foundation Show" which will include 50%-74.99% Simmental and a "Purebred Show" of 75% or greater as long as both divisions have 25 head each. 3/4 bloods will show in the PB Show. • The NSA and the NCC reserves the right to combine the shows if each division does not meet the entry requirements of the Classic. • Genetic status must be printed in the catalog. • An EPD, weight, and scrotal measurement data sheet will be made. The sheet will be given to the judge to use. • The NSA charges an additional 1% sales commission.

• Genetic status must be printed in the catalog Animals must be TF (Tested Free), PF (Pedigree Free), DF (Documented Free) or AF (Assumed Free) to be eligible for the Simmental show/sale. Entries as PR (Population Risk) or CL (Carrier in Lineage) must be blood tested by January 1st. Send test results to both the NSA Office & Cattlemen's Classic Office. Animals testing as carrier will be moved to the OPEN SALE.

Entries will be weighed and measured at the show. • Bulls born after January 1, 2015 has to have a 2.6 WPD of age. • Heifers born January 1, 2015 to August 31, 2015 must be bred. • The Nebraska Limousin Association will receive 1% commission of sales.

CLASSIC OPEN BULL & HEIFER SALE

• This sale is open to all other breeds. Bulls and heifers. The entry must carry a registration paper with a Breed Association. • Entries in this sale must disclose all registration information at entry time.

Pen of 5 TERMS & CONDITIONS

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 24, 2017 AT 4 PM

The heifers will be stalled on the south side of the Exposition Building. The heifers will be displayed in this area during the Classic. The heifers will be video taped on Thursday starting at NOON. The heifers will sell on the video screen on Friday at 4 pm. Commercial, Registered, Open or Bred Heifers will be featured in this sale. The heifers will be judged on Thursday afternoon. A Champion and Reserve Champion Pen will be selected. The Champion Pen will receive \$500 and the Reserve Pen will receive \$250.

1. All entries must include the entry fee of \$250 per pen.
2. Pen size shall be 5 head, selling as a pen not split. No individuals will be sold from the pen. Consignors can have the option to bring an additional heifer for

the pen (making 6 head to the pen). The option can be given for buyers to select the 5 head of choice or buy all 6 head.

3. All heifers must be checked in by Thursday, February 23 at 10 am. Pens must be vacated by 6 pm on Saturday, February 25.
4. ALL catalog information must be turned in with the entries.
5. The Classic commission is 9% per pen. The minimum commission on a pen is \$250.
6. The heifers will have a \$35 bedding fee. Bred heifers will have a \$70 per pen bedding fee.
7. All heifers must be weaned. The maximum age limit shall be 30 months.
